

DESCRIPTION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECT

You, as the data subject, have rights set forth below, indicated in 2016. Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation):

1. know (be informed) about the processing of your data (right to know);
2. access to your data and how they are processed (right of access);
3. to request the rectification or, depending on the purposes of the processing of personal data, the supplementation of incomplete personal data (right of rectification). Please note that we may need to verify the accuracy of any new information you provide;
4. destroy your data or suspend the processing of your data (other than storage) (right to destroy and right to be 'forgotten') if there are reasonable grounds for doing so. Please note that we will not be able to comply with your request for legal destruction in all cases;
5. the right to request that the controller restrict the processing of personal data for one of the legitimate reasons (right to restriction of processing);
6. the right to the portability of the data you have provided to us (right to data portability);
7. the right not to consent to the processing of personal data or to withdraw his or her consent when such data is processed or is intended to be processed in the interests of Profitus. In this case, Profitus will stop processing your data unless it has evidence that it has legitimate reasons to continue processing the data. When data processing is related to direct marketing, you have the right to object at any time and Profitus will stop processing your data for direct marketing purposes.
8. the right to submit a complaint to the [State Data Protection Inspectorate](#). We would appreciate it if you would contact us beforehand to enable us to resolve the dispute with you amicably.

When applying to us for the exercise of the above rights, please fill in the relevant [Form](#) and provide the information requested therein.

Please submit the form by:

You must attach a copy of your personal document to the Form so that we can verify your identity. We will respond to you within 1 month. Please note that, depending on the scope and complexity of your request, this deadline may be extended to 2 months. In any case, you will receive a response about the actions we have taken on your request within 1 month. We will communicate with you in the form of communication you choose, which you will specify in the Form.

The rights of data subjects shall be exercised free of charge, unless the individual's request is manifestly unfounded or disproportionate.

If we have reasonable doubts about your identity, we may ask for additional information to verify it.

Also, if you believe that we are violating the General Data Protection Regulation or other legal acts, regulating data processing, you have the right to submit a complaint to the State Data Protection Inspectorate, address is L. Sapiegos str. 17, LT-10312 Vilnius, <https://vdai.lrv.lt/>.
